JULY 2016: TURQUOISE CONCHO BELT



## Materials and Supplies:

5" of flat leather cording (available in the jewelry section of craft stores)  
Two 1/4" silver jump rings (available in the jewelry section of craft stores)  
Six tiny chips of turquoise (available at bead supply stores)  
silver tone craft metal  
Two 1/4" medallion punches (We used sunburst and flower shaped punches.)  
Tacky glue

## Instructions:

Slip 2 jump rings onto one end of the leather strip and fold over the end to form the cinch of the leather belt. Secure with Tacky glue.



Trim the opposite end of the cord to a point. See illustration.

Use a pencil and make a tiny mark in the center of your leather belt 1" from the pointed end. Make five more marks at ½" increments along the length of the belt.

Using your medallion punches, punch three of each shape from the craft metal. Use a toothpick and Tacky glue to glue a small chip of turquoise in the center of each punched shape.

Using a toothpick, apply a drop of glue to each pencil mark on the belt and glue your conches in place. We did a pattern of flower, sunburst, flower, sunburst.
