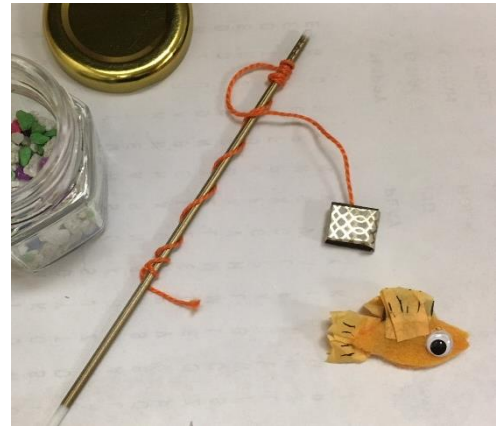

## MONTHLY PROJECTS FOR MAKERS

### AUGUST 2023—PETIT GOLDFISH

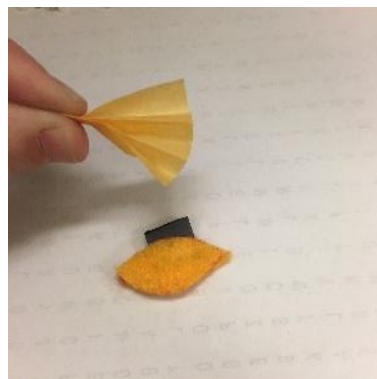
#### Materials:

- Fishing rod (stick)
- String with magnet tied at the end
- Fish body (2 pieces of material w/ magnet inbetween)
- Fish tail fin + Fish top fins (tissue paper)
- Mini jar
- Googly eyes
- Decorative tape (optional)
- Glue
- Aquarium rocks



#### Instructions:

**Step 1:** Using the larger piece of tissue paper: Accordion fold the tissue paper, creating a mini fan.



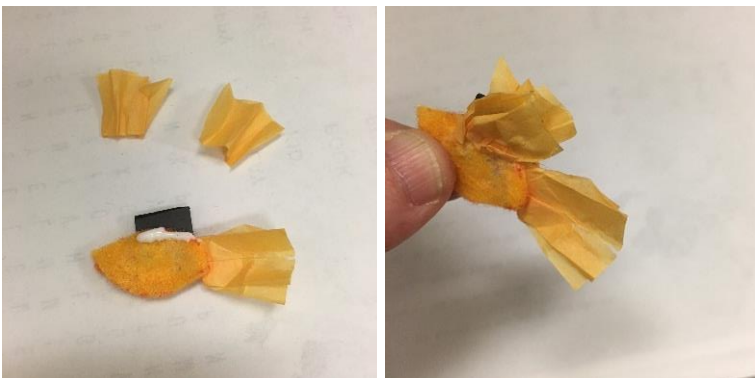
## AUGUST 2023—PETIT GOLDFISH

**Step 2:** Glue this to the fish body to create the tail fin (Hint: lift-up a small piece of the felt and glue the tail between the two body layers to make it extra secure).



**Step 3:** Using the 2 smaller pieces of tissue paper: Accordion fold these sheets to create the top fins.

**Step 4:** Glue one fin on each side of the fish – the top fins will hide some of the exposed magnet.

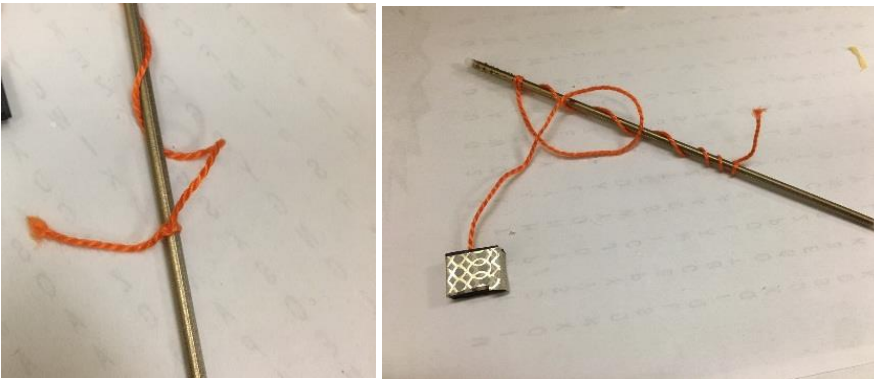
### AUGUST 2023—PETIT GOLDFISH

**Step 5:** Using scissors, trim or shape the top fins and the tail fins as you like.

**Step 6:** Glue on the googly eyes and draw marks on the fins.



**Step 7:** Take the string and tie it in a knot around the fishing pole (about halfway up).





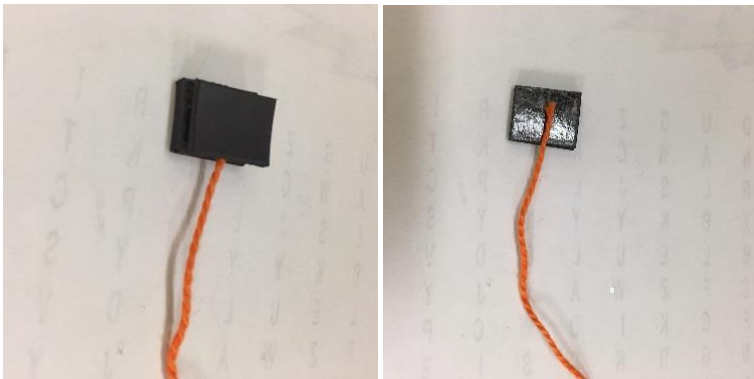

### AUGUST 2023—PETIT GOLDFISH

- Wrap the string around the pole a few more times and tie another knot towards the top of the pole, leaving extra string dangling. Then tie the loose string around the remaining magnets.
