JULY 2023—MINIATURE POPSICLE

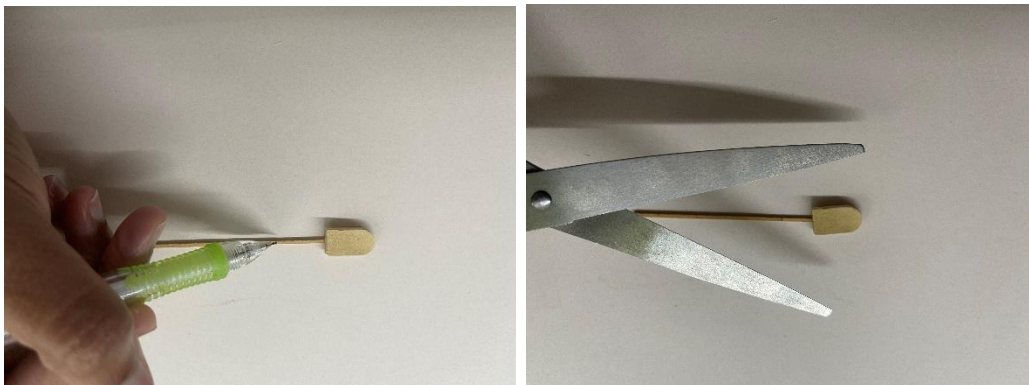
Materials:

- Crayons
- Popsicle stick tips
- Glue
- Mini wooden dowels (popsicle stick)
- Scissors
- Pencil (or any writing utensil)
- Aluminum tin (to melt crayons in...aluminum foil also works)
- Binder clip (holds popsicle sticks together)



Instructions:

Step 1: The wooden sticks that are in your kit are for the miniature popsicle stick. Measure your desired length and cut!





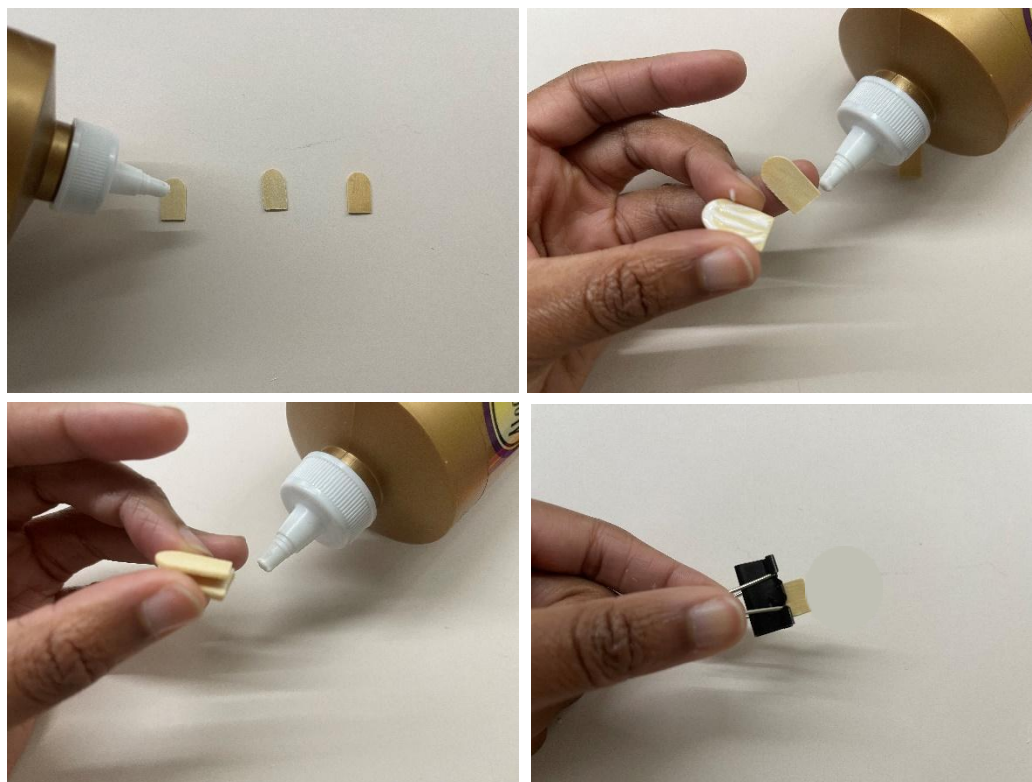

Step 2: Take the three popsicle stick tops, glue them together and use the binder clip to keep them secure

- a. Make a few popsicles and glue on the miniature popsicle stick. Hold for 10-15 seconds. There's also the option to use hot glue (be careful)



Step 3: Pick crayons and start peeling



Step 4: Break them up and put them in an aluminum tin or create your own mini bowl with aluminum foil (make sure there aren't any openings... we don't want anything to spill). If you're doing this at home preheat your oven to 120 degrees and bake for up to 10 minutes. *

Caution, the melted crayons will be HOT, please have an adult help you and be extremely careful.

Step 5: Carefully dip your popsicle a few times in the melted crayons and allow for it to dry. Now you have a miniature crayon popsicle!!
